I hope more forums will be organized for young people and university students aspiring to work in the field of educational cooperation, providing more networking opportunities.

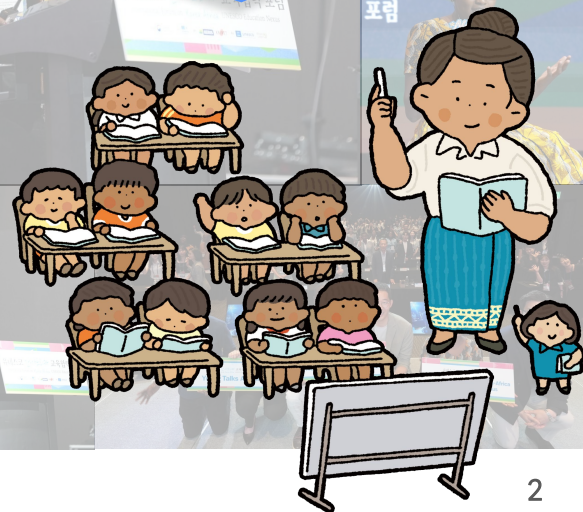
The forum was held at a timely moment, offering valuable support to professionals in the field.

브릿지 프로젝트를 진행 중인 말라위의 교육 환경은 어떤지 아시나요? 말라위 여성부의 성인 문해교육 전략계획(ALE, 2021~2025)을 보면, 약 2150만명의 말라위 국민 가운데 24.5%가 글을 읽고 쓰지 못하며, 특히 여성 비문해자의 비율이 31.2%로 남성(17%)보다 높은 것으로 나타났습니다. 이는 2020년 실시한 제5차 가구 총조사에서도 확인한 사실입니다. 15살 이상 국민 가운데 13.2%가 학교에 다닌 적이 없었고, 특히 공교육의 혜택을 받지 못한 15살 이상 여성의 비율은 남성(8.5%)의 2배가 넘는 18%였습니다.

Men said to be avoiding adult literacy education

Deputy Principal of Magomero Community Development College, Fillimom Mwale, has expressed concern over the low participation of men in adult literacy classes.

Mwale's concerns stem from a recent study conducted by the institution.

After deploying its first cohort of Diploma in Adult Education students to 10 districts for practical attachments, the findings revealed that only a few men showed interest in joining community learning centres.

Mwale made the comments on Saturday during a review meeting of the Bridge Malawi Programme at Magomero College in Chiradzulu.

The programme, which supports adult education in the country, is implemented by the Malawi National Commission for Unesco.

"Our observation is that men, being primary breadwinners, are often too busy with work to attend adult education classes."

"However, we have revised the programme to include additional components such as village savings and loans and technical skills training, alongside basic literacy," Mwale said.

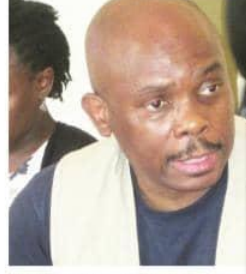
Samuel Ziba, Chief Development Officer, said the programme is designed to be more inclusive and relevant to the needs of men.

"We have developed a multi-component strategy within the programme that will address the needs of men, including providing them with a broader educational experience, which includes vocational training and life skills."

"We were involved in developing the programme in the first place, and we are committed to ensuring it meets the needs of all learners, including men."

The Malawi National Commission for UNESCO has donated relief items worth K40 million to the Forum for the Development of Youth with Disabilities (FDYD) in response to damage caused by Cyclone Freddy last year.

The donation has been made in collaboration with the Korean Commission for UNESCO.

Among others, the assorted items include learning and teaching materials, blankets, buckets, cooking oil, laundry soap and mosquito nets.

FDYD executive director Rex Tikondane Kalima has since described the donation as timely adding that it will go a long way in assisting persons with disabilities who were affected.

"We are very thankful for the relief items and learning materials. During Cyclone Freddy last year, this centre was affected because some of our teachers' houses fell down," said Kalima.

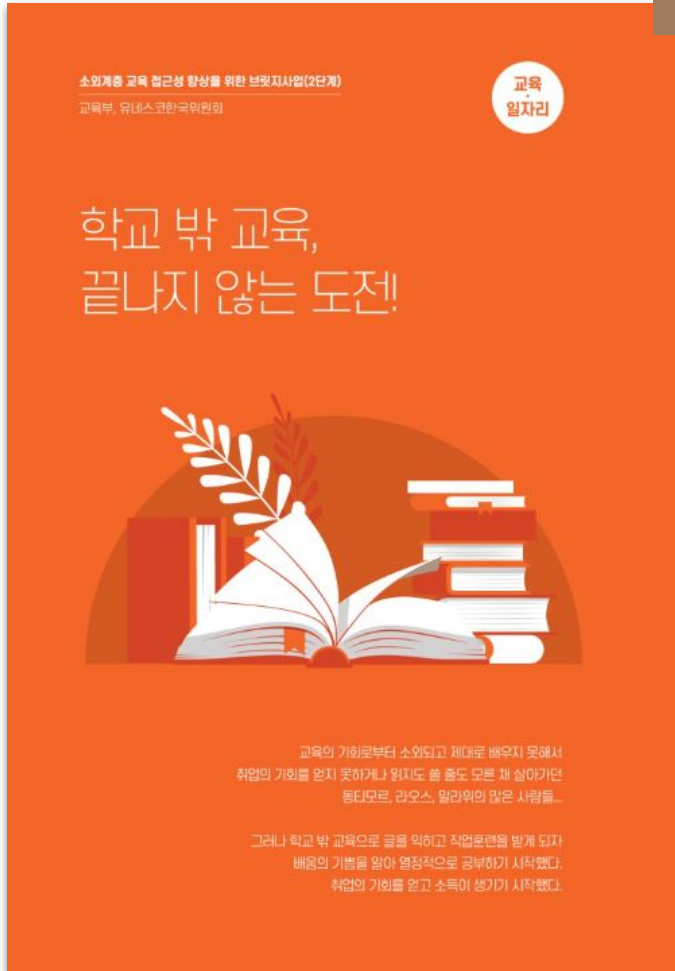

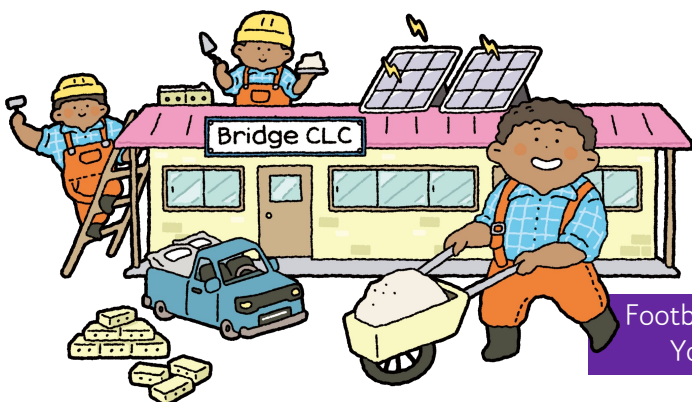

이재성은 마인츠에서 활동하며 착용한 축구화, 국가대표팀 유니폼, 친필 사인 축구공을 경매에 출품했다.

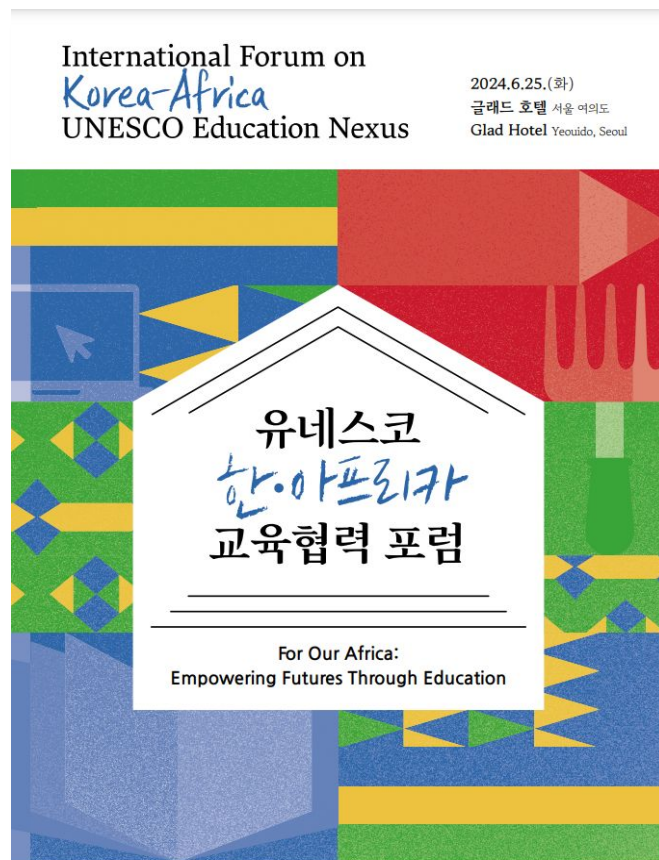
